Course Report

We have recently been blessed with some dry autumnal days, some sunshine, frosty and cold but also some milder warm days. This weather has meant we have been able to remain on the main tees and continue to maintain the course through cutting. It has also meant that the greens have slowed down in growth, so we have been able to reduce the cutting frequency and

iron more often to keep the surface smooth and true.

We have recently applied lawn sand to the greens to help them maintain a healthy sward and fight disease naturally. We have started on some of our winter projects. The trees between 4 and 7 are currently being thinned out to allow light and air get to both holes. Self-set trees and brambles are being removed whilst Oaks and mature trees will be left. The 17th men's tee has been stripped of turf, raised and is currently being levelled with rootzone. The teeing area has also been widened to give more tee positions. The turf has been used to grass over the ditch that divided the carry and the fairway. The 2nd tee has had the turf cut in preparation for being stripped and levelled. These tees will be re-turfed with new turf in the next couple of weeks to give them enough time to grow in before the start of next season.

Can I please remind members that by failing to repair pitchmarks on greens is only going to affect the playing surface for your game. The greens at the minute are in excellent condition but are being damaged by a lack of care and attention to detail.


Bag tags


